METHODOLOGY:

The sample size for the survey is 369 likely Republican primary voters in Pennsylvania and the margin of error is +/-5.1%. Responses were gathered through land line interviews conducted using Interactive Voice Response (IVR). The survey was conducted September 9-10, 2015 by Harper Polling. The total percentages for responses may not equal 100% due to rounding.
