METHODOLOGY:

The sample size for the survey is 400 likely voters in Louisiana Congressional District 3 and the margin of error is +/-4.9%. Responses were gathered through land line interviews conducted using Interactive Voice Response (IVR). The survey was conducted June 16 - 18, 2016 by Harper Polling. The total percentages for responses may not equal 100% due to rounding.
